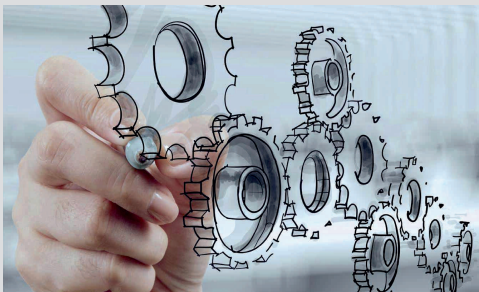


## JITO Projects / Activities in India



### 1 JATF - JITO Administrative Training Foundation is a flagship project of JITO

- **PACE – Public Administration & Civil Services Enhancement**  
Empowers education by preparing deserving youths to join civil services at National and State levels through its five training centres across the country. 132 students have already been placed in various civil services at National level and 214 students in State Civil Services.
- **JELP - JITO Education Loan Programme**  
A scheme to offer subsidy on the interest amount of the education loan to the students. Given subsidy of Rs 195 Lac to 2051 students on Interest paid by them on educational Loans from Banks.
- **SEED - Students Empowering Education & Development**  
Provides interest free loan to meritorious students for higher education. So far, Rs.638 Lacs have been disbursed to more than 578 students.
- **BEAT- Bank PO Exam Aptitude Training**  
Provides coaching for Bank PO Exam. 30 Candidates have been selected so far.
- **Hostel Project**  
Offers lodging & boarding facilities to the students. Hostels announced at Ahmedabad, Aurangabad, Bengaluru (2), Bhilwara, Chennai, Coimbatore, Hubli, Hyderabad, Jodhpur, Kolkata, Mumbai (3), Nasik (2) & Pune. 1<sup>st</sup> Hostel with 50 rooms with a capacity of 150 students is operational in Bengaluru.



## 2 JITO Incubation Centre

A project for incubating new ideas and supporting budding talents in technology and other fields by providing basic facilities, mentoring and assistance in getting financial resources. First State-of-the-art Incubation Centre in Mumbai spreads over 8500 sq.ft.

## 3 JITO Business Networking (JBN)

To meet one of the foremost JITO objective – Economic Empowerment by creating a pan India App based networking platform for Community members for their mutual benefit. It is expected to leverage and unleash the tremendous business and economic power of the Jain community.

## 4 JITO G2G (Going Global)

G2G is an International networking and learning program that inspires members to follow Good-to-Great trajectory. After the first event in Dubai in October 2015, the second G2G event was organised in USA during September 2016 and the 3rd International Business and Networking Conference “JITOPRENEURS 2017” was held in October 2017 at London and 4th edition of JITOPRENEURS held at London in 2018.

## 5 JITO Engineering and Management Program (JEMP)

With a vision to become the most ideal platform for preparing brilliant engineers & management professionals and turning them into successful entrepreneurs & professionals who will drive new age thoughts and innovations for empowerment of the community and nation at large, JITO has envisaged JEMP which will focus on preparing candidates for IITs and IIMs by facilitating coaching and creating a support system for their grooming like mentoring at various stages and creating a conducive environment by establishing hostels for their convenience. To facilitate this, JITO has established:

A hostel in Kota, with capacity of 76 students who are pursuing engineering through IITs, as their career. Students are offered subsidy for coaching, accommodation and food in addition to the mentoring and broadening their vision. The success ratio of the first batch was 100% where 20 students out of 20 appeared, cleared the IIT JEE Advance.

## 6 [JITO Professional Forum](#)

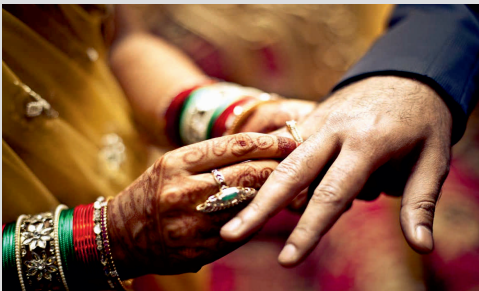
A think tank of various professionals to brainstorm & discuss how to benefit the community at large. The first JITO Professional Forum was held on 2nd September, 2018 at Goa.

## 9 JITO Connect

JITO organizes Global Summit to showcase its sublime transformation from a sedate state. This includes Global Conference, Trade Fair and Jain Pavilion. So far 8 global summits have been held at Bengaluru, Chennai (2), Ahmedabad, Mumbai (3) and Pune.

## 10 JITO International Wing

To build strong relations internationally through networking and achieving synergy of expertise, resources & talent for mutual growth and society upliftment. Presently 11 International Chapters - Dubai, UK, Hongkong Nepal, USA - New York, Thailand, Japan, Kenya, Uganda, Australia & USA - San Francisco. Chapters in Belgium, Singapore, China and Canada are on cards.

## 11 JMAP - JITO Matrimonial Assistance Programme

24 Matrimonial meets held so far at various places. Candidates registered so far - 12,476 (Males – 7,420 / Females – 5,056).

## 12 JITO Youth Wing

The youth wing of JITO has an objective to connect more and more young Jains to the mainstream and to take the advantage of power of youth. Presently, JITO Youth wing are in 40 chapters with 3515 members. National body of Youth Wing is being formed.

## 13 JITO Ladies Wing

The ladies' wing of JITO has an objective to ensure increased participation and representation of ladies by way of exploring the hidden talent & potential. Presently, JITO Ladies wing are in 52 chapters with 3829 members. National body of Ladies Wing is being formed.





#### 14 JEAP - JITO Employment Assistance Programme

JEAP has been instrumental in placement of more than 1800 candidates with 4,405 employers & 17,590 employees registered.
